Job Summary: Responsible for the installation, maintenance, and repair of computers, networks, storage, microwave signals, databases, websites, servers, general purpose input/outputs, security systems, studio equipment, transmitters, HD equipment, RDS & Metadata, audio processing, satellites, telecommunication equipment, and backup systems.

General Responsibilities:
